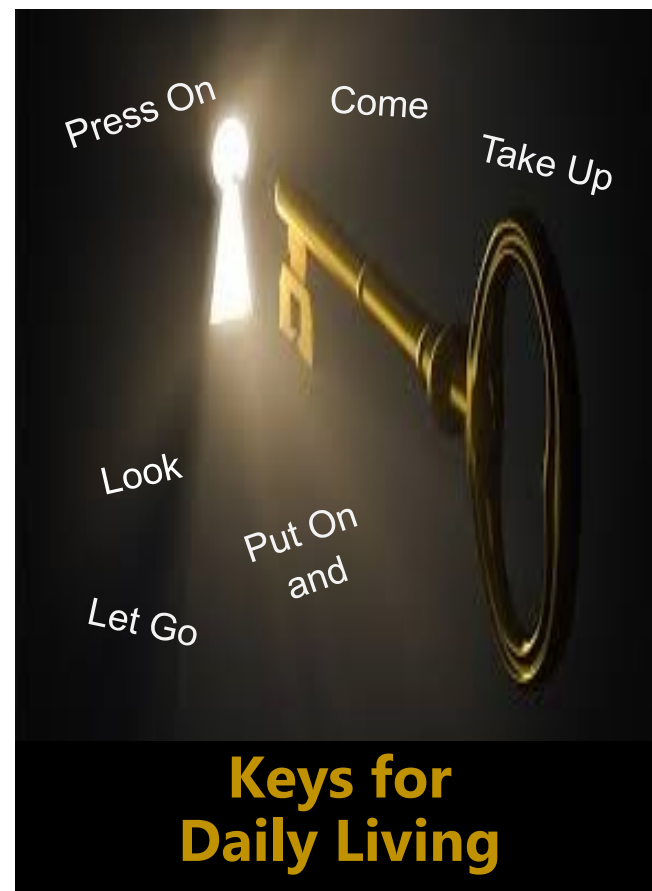

## Keys for Daily Living

Acts 1: 1-11 and Luke 24: 13-26  
Pastor Alan Smith

Jesus had "the talk" with His disciples to be prepared for difficult times. Matthew 24: 6-14

Hold a tension between the dynamic present and the unfolding future WITH the call for consistent daily spiritual life and ministry.

Brokenness and needs would be on our plate for ministry no matter what.

Luke and Acts bridge the life of Jesus and His ministry and the calling of the disciples and the followers of Jesus to embark on the unfolding ministry of the Gospel to the world.

"We were hoping..."

Luke and Acts are sister passages bridging the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus with the ascension and the birth and commissioning of the church.

We are empowered to serve as His witnesses locally, regionally, and across the world.

"Why are you standing around gazing at the sky?"

Why are you looking for the living among the dead?  
"That's where WE LEFT HIM..."

Jesus asked the family of Lazarus in John 11: "Where have you laid him?" "Where have you left him?" Where did things/life stop?
