Steams and Springs in the Desert

The challenge of the need to satisfy a deep spiritual thirst. Symptoms of dehydration (Physically? Spiritually?) – weakness, disorientation, impaired thought processing, confusion, inability to speak clearly (dry mouth)

Hunger and thirst are natural expected realities on the journey, not mere gnawing invasions of discomfort or distractions.

Factors that exacerbated our needs – bitterness, regrets, fears, the reality of an unpredictable journey.

Massah (testing) and Meribah (quarrelling).

The dehydration of a journey through a spiritual wilderness

Marah and Elim: Exodus 15: 22-27

The spiritual life, the journey of faith, needs continuous a life sustaining supply.

Bitterness in leaving Egypt became an infection in the community of faith.

Psalm 42

Psalm 63:1-5

Symptoms of Spiritual Dryness:

1. I am irritable and easily put out.
2. I am impatient with those close to me .
3. I am deceitful in that I often think and feel differently than I act and reveal
4. Most of my discipleship has been crudely ambitious.
5. I am more concerned with what the people think of me, than what they think about my Lord

6. I have a growing list of missed opportunities to witness and serve.
7. I am envious of others and their walk rather than open to encourage, pray for and with them
8. I am driven in pain to conclude that others have not felt drawn to the Christian life because of me.
9. I find slight envies in my heart at the greater success of others in faith or ministry

God still provides water from “the rock”.
