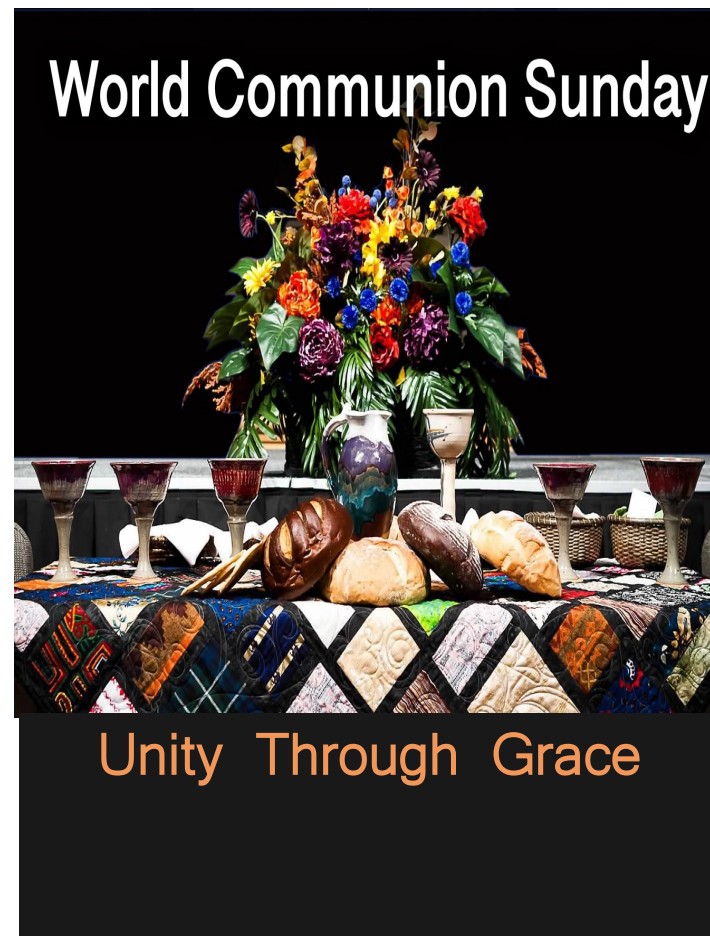

There is an opportunity that the people of God be those who must reach beyond the experience, mentality and activity of our own human attempts and enlist the very means of the grace of God into the journey.

I Corinthians 10:1-17...
