The God I Can See

Pastor Alan Smith Exodus 32: 1-14

Exodus 20:1-6, 22-25...
"Just do something....!"
Silence is difficult.

Three siblings – Miriam – the oldest; Moses, the youngest. And Aaron – the middle child, the one left holding the fort.

The people want something they can see to lead them.

This wasn't the first time that the people have hit a snag, caught between a pursuing army and a sea, ran out of water, needed food...

They want a new god.

Psalm 135: 15-18

What do you look for when the future is uncertain, when the plan is uncertain, when the silence is unbearable?

When God/leadership doesn't move fast enough, we sometimes choose to do what we have the capability of accomplishing...

How big a jump is it from confusion over our circumstances and regret over our decisions -- to idolatry?

Someone to do something rather than do something to be somebody.

Moses did not condemn the people, but rather redemptively prayed for their salvation and life ahead.

God gave Moses the opportunity to recognize the value of sinful people and seek not their judgment but God's love and mercy.
