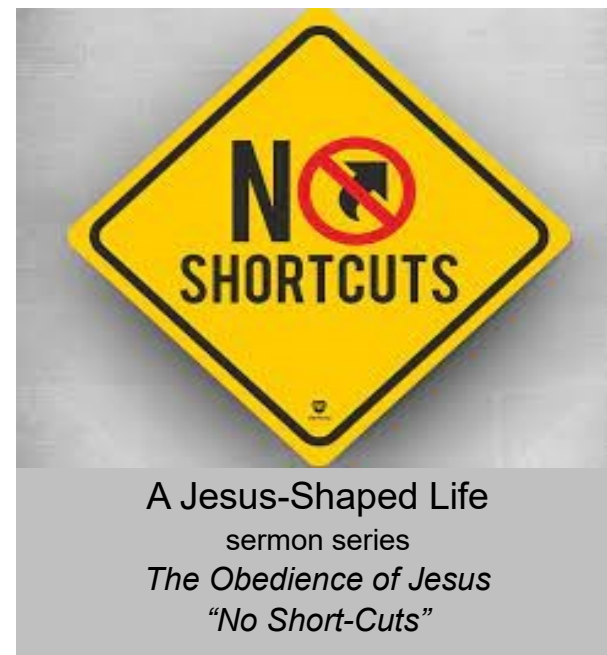

**A Jesus Shaped Life:
The Obedience of Jesus**

Matthew 5:17-20; 1 John 2:1-6

Jesus lived a life of obedience to God his Father. Jesus said, “Just as your heavenly Father is complete in showing love to everyone, so also you must be complete.” [Matt 5:48 CEB] That is a Jesus shaped life.
