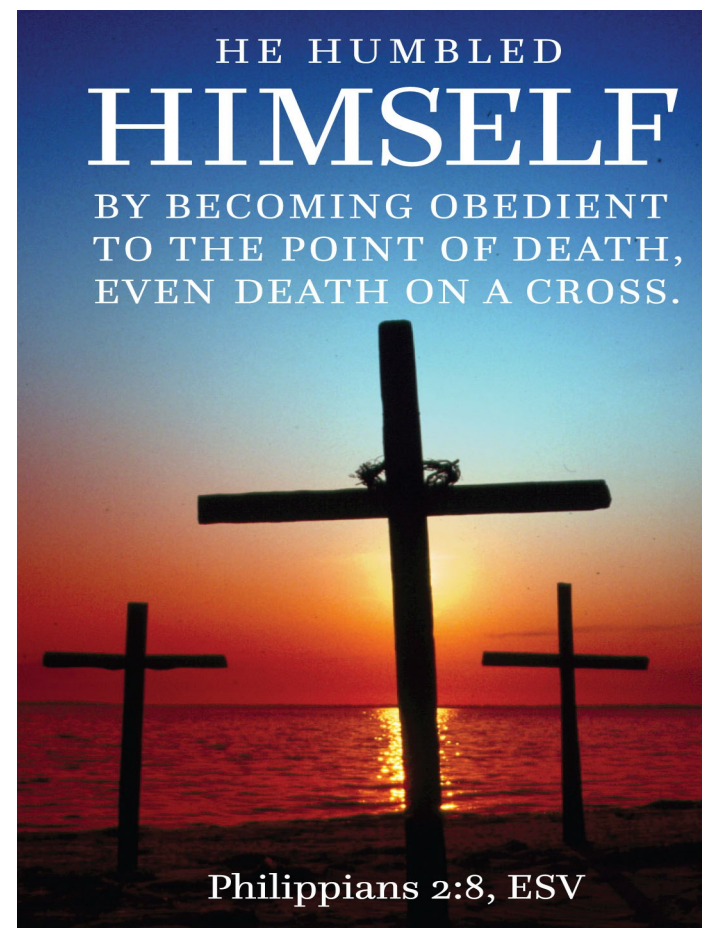

The Courage of Jesus

“Dying to Save Yourself”

Philippians 2: 1-11; Luke 9:23-26

Pastor Janet Sattel

“If any of you want to become my followers, you must deny yourself and take up your cross and follow me.” This is to be the pattern of our lives – a Jesus shaped life is in the shape of the cross.

To deny ourselves does not mean self-rejection or self-hatred. To be humble doesn’t mean we think less of ourselves, what it does mean is that we are not to be the center of our world. Instead, we must place God at the center of our lives

Jesus laid his life down for us, and in order for us to find true life we must lay down our lives for him. Only in being empty will we find ourselves truly full, filled to the fullness of God. Remember that Jesus said, “For whoever wants to save their life will lose it but whoever loses their life for me will save it.” The fullness of God is found at the cross.

The call to discipleship is not free, but it is freeing. The call comes at a price: self-denial. But it comes with a rich reward of self-actualization - the new self that is found in living with Christ.

We must choose between the world and the cross. Isn’t it absurd to think that we can guarantee a better life for ourselves than what God Almighty, the Creator of the Universe can give us?

Jesus was vindicated and raised in glory. He will come again in triumph and we have the assurance that we will share in his glory if we hold fast to our commitment to him.

We must follow Jesus – a Jesus shaped life is

one that is V shaped – only when we die to self will we rise to new life here on earth. “Humble yourself in the sight of the Lord – and he will lift you up.” James 4:10
