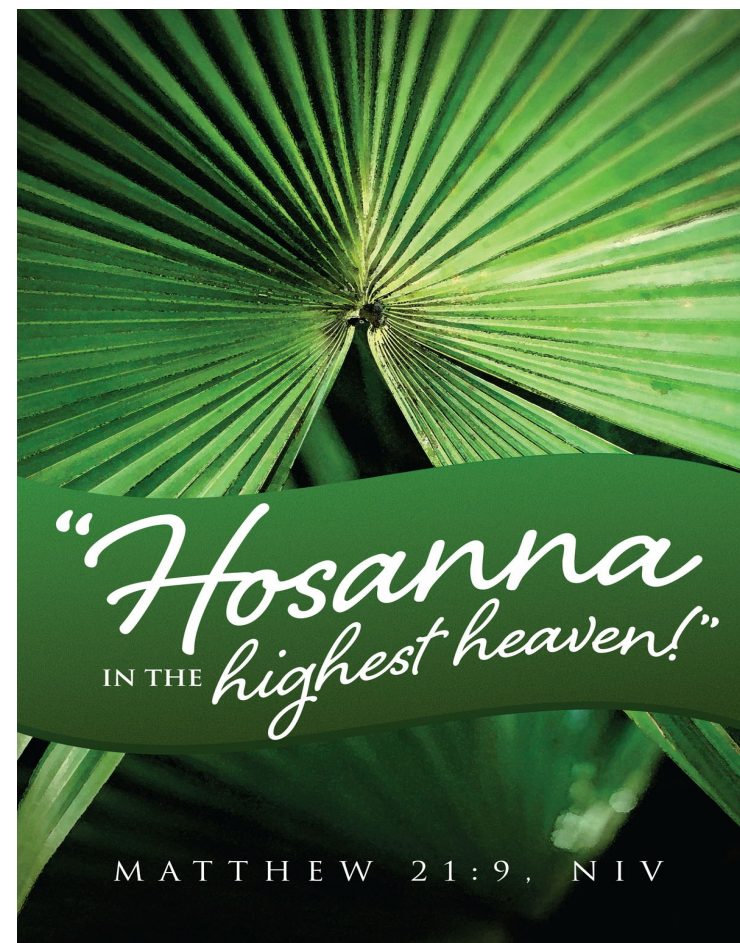

A Jesus-Shaped Life: The Mission of Jesus

*“Our Mission Now”
Luke 15:4-10; Luke 19:28b-40
Pastor Janet Sadel*

The mission of Jesus was to bring complete salvation, and salvation for all.

God has never given up – God calls us and woos us. Prevenient Grace is grace that goes before us: the Holy Spirit is active and involved in the heart of every single person who ever lived, who lives today and who will ever live.

Jesus told the parable of the lost sheep and the lost coin to tell us that God is actively searching for lost people. The Mission of Jesus is to restore our relationship with God. Jesus showed us how to reconnect with God – repent of our sin, change our ways, turn to God and start a new life with him.

Now we are to seek out the lost. In fact, Jesus' final words to the disciples, we call it the Great Commission, was go to all the nations making disciples.

This is no small matter – image that the angels in heaven rejoice every time someone turns to God! There is only one who can really save. His name is Jesus, from the Hebrew Yeshua, which means “God saves.” This is the mission of Jesus.

Our mission now is to share with the world the news of Jesus. As Christ followers, a Jesus shaped life is one that shares the Good News that God has come to us in Jesus.

Ask the Holy Spirit to give you courage and to make you aware of someone who is in need. When we share the good news of Jesus, we are sharing the mission of Jesus and we become more and more like Jesus. That is a Jesus-shaped life.
