GOD OF SECOND CHANCES

John 21:1-19; Acts 9:1-6
Reverend Janet Sattel

Peter had denied Jesus three times. He had chosen self-love over love of Jesus. He must have had tremendous guilt.

Peter had denied his Lord three times, and now he was being given the opportunity by his very Lord to affirm his love for him, three times. Jesus gives Peter a second chance.

Peter is not alone in receiving a second chance from the Lord. Just read through the bible and you will find countless stories of those who needed, and received, second chances from God. Abraham, Moses, King David, all these and more made critical errors in following God's ways.

Paul would later call himself "Chief among sinners," but God showed him mercy so that he could be an example for us. All who turn to God are given a second chance, because our God is a God of second chances.

When we love Jesus more than self, then we find that we can truly love ourselves the way we should. And that's because we begin to love ourselves through Jesus' eyes – we love ourselves the way that Jesus loves us – with a true and pure love. Any other kind of love is the narcissistic kind of love that that demands more than it offers.

Instead, if we lay aside our own self-love, and allow our love for Jesus to wash back onto ourselves, then we are filled with true love for ourselves and true love for others. God has created us for himself, and until we live in his love, we will never be the complete and balanced human beings we were made to be.
