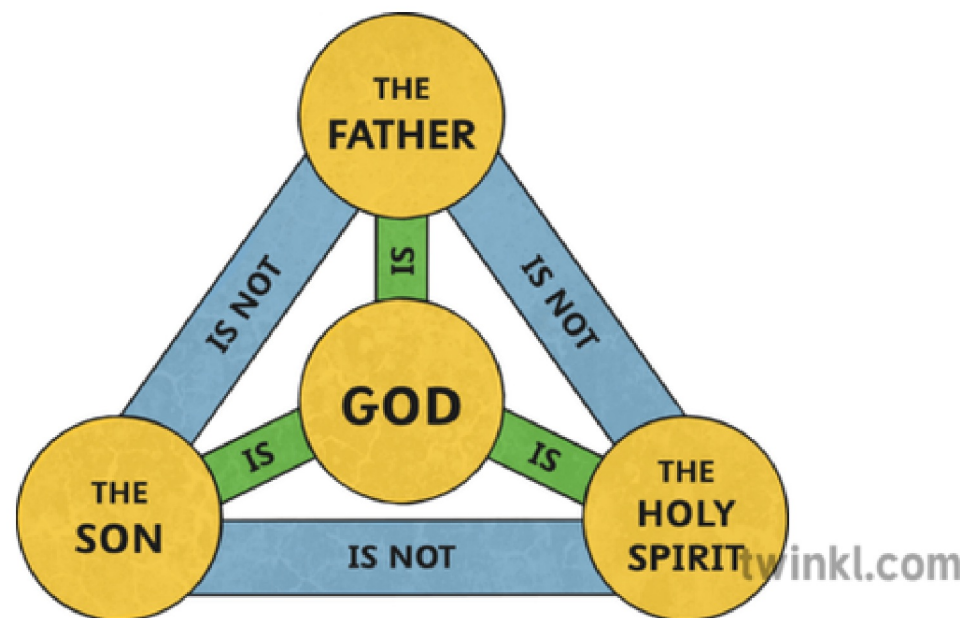

Sermon Outline: *Fill 'er Up*

Psalm 8; John 16:12-15

"There is a God-shaped vacuum in the heart of every man which cannot be filled by any created thing, but only by God the Creator made known through Jesus Christ." ~ Blaise Pascal

On the Day of Pentecost God sent his Holy Spirit to dwell within each believer, filling that vacuum and adopting us as his children.

The Trinity is the first, and ultimate example of community. Three in one: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. God is community and God is in community.

1 Cor 3:16-17 ~ All of us gathered together are the temple of the Holy Spirit. We are meant to be in community and through the Holy Spirit we can touch each other's souls.

Revelation 3:20 ~ We must continually invite God into our lives, daily.

We cannot run on empty and expect to be content in life. Every day we need to wake up and ask the Holy Spirit to fill us.

Jesus said he came in order to give us life - abundant life! But we can only have this life when we ask for it - we must come every day and invite God into our hearts.

St. Augustine said, "our hearts are restless until they find rest in you." We are never satisfied until we are filled with the Holy Spirit.
