KEY POINT.... Our hearts are what matter to God.


DAILY CHALLENGE FROM THE PARENTING CLASS

THE FIRST REQUIREMENT:

- * We parents must possess a foundation upon which to base our lives and which can withstand the test of time—something that will support us through every phase of living: adolescence, young adulthood, middle age, old age, marriage crises, financial crises, children's crises, energy crises, and especially, a rapidly changing society in which spiritual values are swiftly eroding.
- * Parents must possess the most important thing in life. A personal, intimate relationship with God through His Son Jesus Christ.

THE SECOND REQUIREMENT:

- * In order to give a child what we have is that a child identify with his parents so as to accept and incorporate the parents' values. If the child does not feel loved and accepted, he has a real difficulty identifying with his parents and their values.
- * To give a child the close relationship with God which they possess, parents must make sure that a child feels unconditionally loved. Just as God loves us—unconditionally.
