Sermon Outline:

"One in Ten"
Luke 17:11-19
Pastor Janet Sattel

- Only one of the ten affected with leprosy turns around to thank Jesus.
- Jesus says to him, "Your faith has made you well" or "your faith has saved you." In this case, salvation is being made whole, being reconciled with God and with other people.
- Salvation is being restored in your life and in your faith. Salvation came to the Samaritan when he realized who God is and who he is as God's beloved child - it was then that his attitude changed from lamenting to Thanksgiving; from being discouraged and seeing everything that's wrong with this world to joy.
- When we focus inwardly, all we see is ourselves and our own problems. Instead, when we gaze at the Savior, we see love - and we see that he loves us, faults and all.
- He returned to Jesus - the scripture says, "he turned back." This phrase: turning around is a description for the believer's reaction to Jesus. The word "repentance" means "to turn around" - it involves a movement of the whole person - not the physical person, but the spiritual person - the soul inside is moved by what Jesus has done. It is turning your life around and looking to Jesus - looking him full in the face and recognizing what God has done for us.
- Living a life of faith is living a life of gratitude. When we practice gratitude we find that our faith is increased. The practice of gratitude changes our attitude and when our attitude is changed, so are we.
- The antidote to anxiety is gratitude. Only one in ten lepers went back to thank Jesus. Only one in ten had his heart made whole. Let us be the one in ten who is thankful, who has a grateful heart, a healed heart, a whole heart that is overflowing with joy and the love of God.
