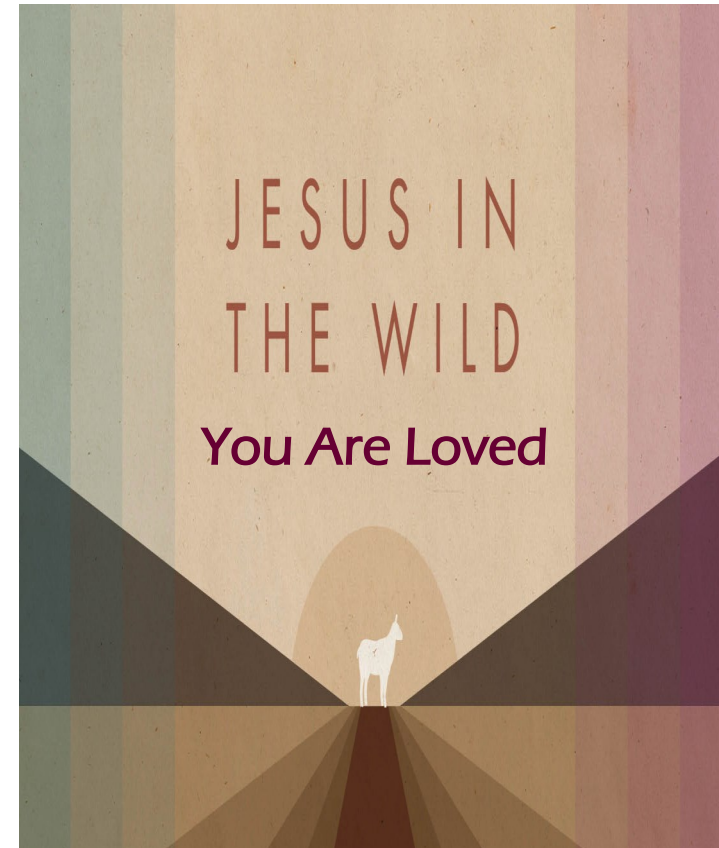

Sending Forth

The devil is not equal with God; he is a created being and thus is less than God.

He is devious and seeks to destroy us by pulling us away from God, away from our identity as God's beloved.

Because of all that Jesus did for us on the cross, we are worthy of God's love. There is nothing we can do to earn this love nor take it away.

This is our identity: we are his beloved. Receive God's love in all its fullness, allow God's love to sink into our souls.

identity in Christ. We have such a precious gift from God, the life that our creator God has given to us is a gift.
